



Statement of the Brotherhood of Christian Businessmen and Professionals (BCBP) on Joining the Trillion Peso March Movement

Guided by our core advocacy “Be Honest” and our mission to bring Christ into the marketplace and the nation, we join the Trillion Peso March Movement as an act of faith, as a moral imperative.
